❖ Teaching Young Writers:

❖ Promoting Fluency

Grades K - 3

This workshop takes a closer look at the strategies and techniques for fluency development in grades K-3. With hands-on activities and an optional "Make & Take".

❖ Guided Reading:

This workshop provides participants with demonstration lessons and activities to use during Guided Reading instruction or small group reading instruction.

Using trade books, picture books, magazines, and internet sources with differentiated ideas and hands-on activities.

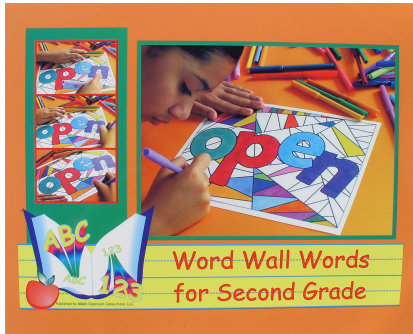
